



2012-2015 Funding Call: Additional Guidance for College JRFs

The Oxford Martin School's research support is restricted to departments and Faculties of the University. Therefore, college-only staff are not eligible to apply. After consultation with the Divisions, we have decided to make an exception in the case of college-only postdoctoral Junior Research Fellows (JRFs). The following guidance specifies the conditions under which a JRF without a department or Faculty appointment may apply.

Postdoctoral JRFs are spread across the four Divisions, but JRFs without departmental or Faculty attachments are concentrated primarily in the Humanities and Social Sciences. The School recognises the contribution these young scholars make to the University and invites expressions of interest from college-only JRFs, provided:

- You are in post at the start of the grant period (1 October 2012). The School does not provide bridging support.
- A department or Faculty agrees to sponsor your expression of interest on the same terms as it would support a research grant application to an external body with your name as Principal Investigator. It is your responsibility to ensure that the department or Faculty would support a grant application in their name, should they be successful beyond Stage 1 (on the understanding that full salary costs for PIs are unlikely to be met).

If a department or Faculty agrees to support your expression of interest, please note this in the "Employment Status" section of the form. Under "Type of Post", list your college post and details of the department or Faculty supporting your expression of interest.

Please note: This guidance is for JRFs who hold college-only appointments; JRFs who hold a contract with a department or Faculty should refer to our main guidance notes to determine their eligibility.
